The target group for scholarships are graduates and postgraduates from Sub-Saharan Africa with a first academic degree if applying for a Master programme, or with a Master degree if applying for a doctoral programme who want to pursue Master's or PhD courses in their home country or which they have a residence permit (so called In-Country scholarships) or in another Sub-Saharan African country or which they do not have a residence permit (In-Region scholarships).

Please note that South African (ZA) students cannot apply for In-Region scholarships through this programme tender. In-Country students from South Africa (ZA) can apply through the NRF/DAAD scholarship programme.

Female applicants and candidates from less privileged regions or groups are especially encouraged to participate in the programme!
