Application Documents:

- Letter of motivation in English including the following questions: "Why do I want to apply to this study program?" & "Why is the program important in the overall perspective?"
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Proof of university degree by a university certificate and a transcript of records.

 IMPORTANT: You must have your foreign degree certificate recognised by the Studienkolleg Konstanz. This can take up to 6 weeks. You can find more information on this in the Guide.
- Proof of English language proficiency level B2 by means of a certificate such as TOEFL or Cambridge Certificate. If your university degree is based on an English-language study programme, please submit proof of this from your university. In this case, you do not need a language certificate.
- Support Letter of employer to grant leave
- Passport copy

Costs:

- Tuition fees of 4,500 € per semester
- Tuition fees can be decreased in accordance with your income.
- Travel costs of approx. 10,000 euros for the entire degree programme, for which grants are available
