This course helps students identify the expected goals of the components of a formal research proposal and supports them in writing up their research in a coherent way. It guides them towards demonstrating an intended, well-structured study and a critical declaration of their positionality as researchers

The course consists of self-directed learning on the Moodle platform and six Zoom sessions (with 5 of them being in one week).

WHAT WE EXPECT

- Participation in 6 Zoom sessions (approx. 2 hours each)
- Completion of the activities on Moodle
- Engagement in 2 additional hours per week (in your own time)
